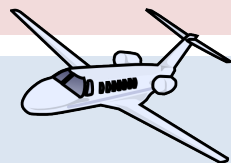


Phonics: Phase 3

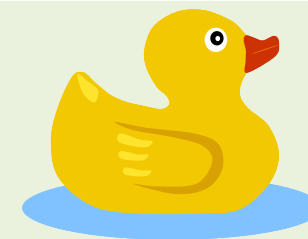
Aim - By the time they reach Phase 3, children will already be able to blend and segment words containing the 19 letters taught in Phase 2. During Phase 3, children will also learn the letter names using an alphabet song, although they will continue to use the sounds when decoding words.

Set 6 - j, v, w, x



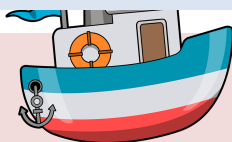
Jam, Jill, jet, jog, Jack, Jen, jet-lag, jacket.

Yap, yes, yet, yell, yum-yum.
Zip, Zack, buzz, jazz, zigzag.
Quiz, quit, quick, quack, liquid.

Consonant digraphs: ch, sh, th, ng



Chop, chin, chug, check, such, chip, chill, much.
Ship, shop, shed, shed, fish, shock, cash, bash.
Them, then, that, this, with, moth, thin, thick.
Ring, rang, hang, song, wing, rung, king, long.

Vowel digraphs: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er

Wait, gail, hail, see, feel, weep, high, sigh, light,
coat, load, goat, too, zoo, boot, bar, car, bark,
